LINCOLN COUNTY FAIR

QUEEN, PRINCESS, TINY PRINCESS CONTEST RULES

Contestants are limited to Lincoln County residents

(Must be a Lincoln County land owner or reside within the County)

- 1. Queen contestants must be age 16 21 at Fair time.
- 2 Princess contestants must be age 8 15 at Fair time.
- Tiny princess contestants must be age 5 7 at Fair time.
- 4. The contestants will be judged on the following:

Horsemanship

Personal Interview

Attire

Impromptu Questions

Poise

Personality

- 5. The Royalty chosen will be required to represent Lincoln County during the Fair and Rodeo, and at different functions throughout the year. They must be present and participate in the Rodeo Grand Entries both nights. They must also represent the Fair in at least 3 county events during their year of reigning. These will include Labor Day in Pioche, LCHS and/or PVHS Homecoming parades, Homecoming Parade in Caliente, Rachel Days in Rachel, 4th of July Parade in Alamo or Caliente, or Pioneer Days in Panaca. It is optional which events they will attend out of county. These events could include Dixie Roundup in St. George, September P.R.C.A. rodeo in Cedar City, or Clark County Fair in Logandale. They will be required to assist with the Queen/Princess contest by demonstrating patterns for the contestants and being present at Crowning of next year's royalty.
- 6. The prizes awarded the Queen, Princess, and Tiny Princess will be as follows:

Queen: Buckle, flowers, Crown and Sash, \$100 traveling money

Princess: Buckle, flowers, Crown and sash, \$50 traveling money

Tiny Princess: Buckle, flowers, Crown and sash, \$50 traveling money

Attendants: Sash and flowers

- If Queen should marry, or fail to appear as required, she will forfeit her crown and travel money.
- 8. Once a contestant has been chosen as Queen for Lincoln County Fair, she is ineligible to try out for Queen again for three (3) years. In the event that there are no other contestants for the Fair contest, reigning Queen will automatically be reinstated for another term.
- Above rule applies to Princess Contestants also.
